hBA have 24 CCTV cameras spread over the main street of honley and covering Magdale. These cameras have been an asset for the village in reducing anti social behaviour, helping to establish events happening and identifying suspects. The CCTV is managed by a company called Site Sniper who service, repair and monitor the system to ensure it is in good working order each year.

This grant was to pay for this annual maintenance contract

What were the benefits of your project?	Reduction of anti social behaviour, giving residents peace of mind that they are safe in the village day or night. Ability to check for details whenever an incident takes place in the village
Who benefited from the project and the grant awarded?	Over 6000 residents and business owners and visitors to the village West Yorkshire police now have direct access to the CCTV for any reported crime
How many people	6000 residents, businesses and 000s of visitors

benefited?	West Yorkshire police who have checked CCTV several times for evidence.
Have you achieved what you were trying to do?	One occasion a foreign gentleman coerced an elderly couple visiting the village into following them home and asking for a large amount of money to purchase an expensive item of clothing. Little was known about the vehicle or description but apparently he had been reported doing the same thing in surrounding villages. Our CCTV was able to provide a photo of the man in the car and the registration which allowed the police to visit the individual to speak to him about his behaviour
